Last year, my story took a dramatic turn, making this letter is the most difficult I've ever shared. It cuts to the very core of my heart. It is the reason Redeemed2Repeat began and the reason Redeemed2Repeat must continue. However, the darkest and most difficult year for my family has given way for the Lord to do a beautiful work. Enclosed, in her own words, my daughter, Grace gives a peek into the devastation of addiction, and the dramatic power of redemption. Please take a few minutes to read her story.

**In 2016, 482 people died from prescription opioid overdose in Arizona.
On October 13, 2016 Rob Beck was one of them.**

The devastating effects of addiction to families is indescribable, but as Grace so beautifully shared, God's promises are still true and He brings light to the darkness. Redeemed2Repeat exists to proclaim the transforming power of Jesus Christ to people who have been told they will always be addicts. With partners like you, we are bringing people face-to-face with a loving and gracious God who can break the chains of addiction and set them free, not just make them sober. This not only changes the individual but entire families who will not have to experience what my family experienced. Thank you for investing in families like Michelle's family, Tracy's family, Jason's family, Antoinette, Amy, Mary, Jen and the list continues... These families are forever changed because of the power of Christ, His lasting freedom, and your investment to declare the message of freedom to those who are caught in the bondage of a lie.

Currently, Redeemed2Repeat is \$2,000 short each month, which is where your partnership comes in. A group of generous partners have offered to match up to \$1,000 per month for the next year! This means your new monthly donation (or monthly increase) will be doubled for twelve months. Our goal is to raise \$1,000 in new monthly or increased monthly gifts, giving us the \$2,000 needed to meet our budget, and continue to save lives and families. "It is for freedom that Christ has set us free!" Galatians 5:1. We celebrate the goodness of God in these families and His restoration work that continues in them.
